#### Map, Directions and Parking Information

This information will be emailed to all delegates prior to the event.

Please report to reception where you will be directed to the lecture theatre.

If you are travelling to the Business School by car, please access via the West Entrance. There is a designated visitor's car park situated on the right hand side of the access road alongside the Skell and Dearne buildings, labelled as 50 and 16 respectively on the map that will be circulated. The car park is barrier-controlled and you can collect an exit disc from Nidd reception on your arrival.
